2 PostDoc Positions

for female researchers

The Faculty of Informatics invites applications from female researchers for two full time postdoctoral positions. The announcement of these positions is a special measure by the Faculty of Informatics to increase female employment in scientific positions.

Required qualifications include a Ph.D. in computer science or business informatics or a closely related informatics discipline. The positions are limited to 6 years.
Intended commencement of duties: as soon as possible.

The successful candidates will be assigned to one of the faculty institutes. Duties include research and teaching. The research area must be part of the faculty's research focus (see <http://www.informatik.tuwien.ac.at/research/areas/>). Additionally these positions will receive a starter pack for travel expenses and equipment.

The application documents should include a CV with peer-reviewed publication list, a 1-2 page letter of motivation, and a 5-7 page research statement, including an abstract, a short description of previous research and an agenda for future research, with plans for how that agenda will be realised. Research experience in multiple research facilities is a plus.
